The board of education and the administrative staff shall assist each new member-elect to understand the board's functions, policies, procedures, and operation of the school system before he or she takes office. Each member-elect shall:

- 1. Be given selected material on the function of the board of education and the school system.
- 2. Be invited to attend board meetings and to participate in its discussions.
- 3. Be invited to meet with the superintendent of schools and other administrative personnel to discuss services they perform for the board.
- 4. Be given a copy of school board policies, bylaws, administrative regulations, and copies of pertinent materials developed by the state school board association.
